

Dear Sacred Heart Family,

Greetings from Sacred Heart School! As we approach the upcoming school year, we are excited to provide you with the necessary information for the registration process.

Attached herewith, you will find detailed registration information, including important dates, required documentation, and guidelines to ensure a smooth enrollment process for the upcoming academic year. We encourage you to review the materials carefully and reach out to us if you have any questions or concerns. It is important to get registration in quickly, as it affects our staffing and how many classrooms we will need, per grade level.

We would like to bring to your attention that there has been a 7.4% increase in tuition for the upcoming school year. This decision was made after careful consideration and with the approval of the School Board. The increase is attributed to a 9.1% rise in overall costs, including a 4.1% increase in the teacher scale and a 5% inflation adjustment.

Over the past 20 years, the average annual tuition increase has been around 6%. However, in the two years following the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, we made a conscious effort to minimize the financial burden on our school community by raising tuition by only 1% each year. The Parish generously absorbed the additional costs during this period.

We want to express our deepest gratitude for your understanding and support during these times. It is important to recognize that the Parish covers a significant portion of the cost to educate each child, making Catholic education accessible to our community. Your commitment to Sacred Heart School plays a vital role in preserving the values and traditions that make our institution unique.

We understand the financial considerations families face, and we assure you that every effort has been made to keep the increase minimal while maintaining the quality of education and resources provided to your child. We firmly believe that Sacred Heart School is worth every penny, and we are dedicated to providing an enriching and rewarding educational experience for all students.
